62000: Migration and Education: A Comparative Perspective

Beschreibung, Lern- und Qualifikationsziele:

As immigration is present in many countries all over the world, schools are increasingly being challenged to provide equal educational opportunities for student bodies that are socially and culturally diverse and multilingual. Students with a migration background are often less successful in school than their native peers. Educational research has provided data and analyses of these disparities. Not only are there differences between countries (some educational systems integrate better than others), but some ethnic groups achieve better results than others. The aim of this seminar is to get acquainted with the topic of educational achievement and migration comparing data and educational policies of different countries. Examples of best practice designed to enhance the educational achievement of migrants will be studied in order to acquire knowledge about pedagogical innovations which are applicable in similar contexts of multilingualism and diversity.
