The keynote lecture by distinguished scholar and music producer Lucy Durán will present ethnomusicological field research across the globe through the lens of comparative cross-cultural research. She will particularly highlight the longue durée dimension of researching musicians and their families across

generations and the potential for cross-cultural research, taking examples from her own fieldwork in Mexico/ Cuba, West Africa and Southeast Europe over five decades. With introducing the prize winning AHRC-funded "Growing into Music" project on musical knowledge transmission

in six different cultures she will highlight her approach adding a non-textual multimedia dimension to her novel and deep understanding of musical cultures.
